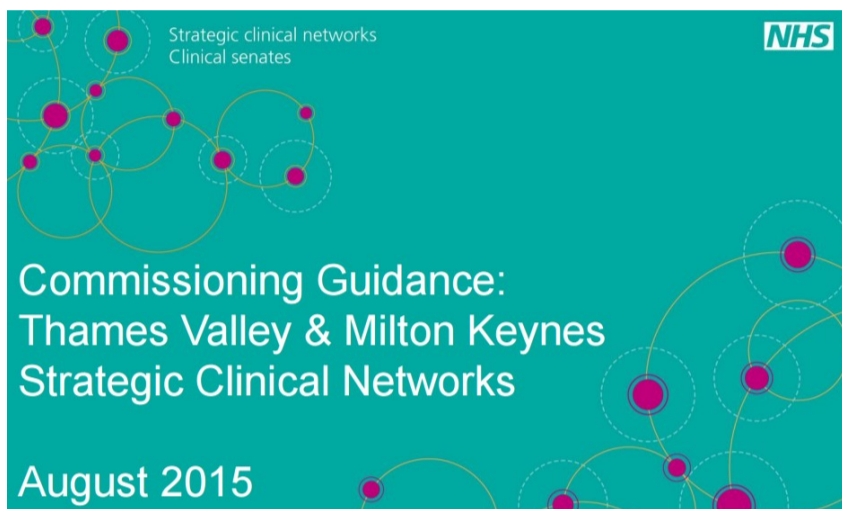


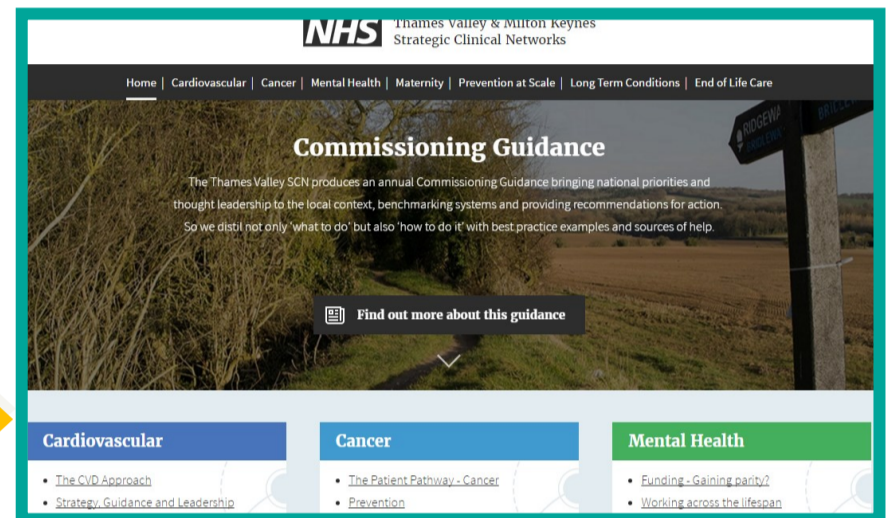

Thames Valley priorities for Dementia - 2016/17

The report was presented at the Thames Valley Senate where it was formally agreed that there is not sufficient capacity in maternity services for the next 10 years. Consequently the TV Senate will be leading a piece of work to identify how to address the capacity issue across the

Support Thames Valley CCGs in achieving Diagnosis rates and eliminating variation in performance

TVSCN will:

- provide focused and co-ordinated clinical advice and leadership directed at bringing a positive impact on performance

Support Thames Valley CCGs to improve both provision and quality of post-diagnostic care for people with Dementia and their carers

TVSCN will:

- disseminate learning from the Dementia Friendly Practice Project which has been shown to have a positive impact on both the quality of post-diagnostic care and the meeting of the Dementia Diagnosis standard
- identify examples of best practice in post-diagnostic care to share learning to drive further improvement and improve quality
