

SUCCESS OF POPULAR METHODS COMPARED WITH GOING COLD TURKEY



The study used going cold turkey as the baseline

No more successful than cold turkey probably because people don't use enough



225% More successful

Quitting with no support

NRT

Using Nicotine Replacement Therapy without professional support

E-CIGARETTES

Using electronic cigarettes without professional support

SUPPORT AND **MEDICATION**

Combined specialist support and prescription medication*

STOP SMOKING SERVICES MATTER – HERE'S WHY




For the 2/3 of smokers who want to quit, Stop Smoking Services are the most effective way to kick the habit for good.



Smokers are over three times more likely to quit when using a Stop Smoking Service than going cold turkey.

In 2014-15, 450,000 people tried to quit with the help of an English Stop Smoking Service.


A brief history

DESPITE RING-FENCE UNTIL 2017/18

- Reductions of £200m 'in-year' cuts to public health budgets in 2015/16
- Planed cuts of 9.7% by 2020/21
- No agreed formula to fund public health at local authority level














Budgetary cuts impact staff time







Conclusions

STOP SMOKING SERVICES REMAIN UNDER PRESSURE

- Budget cuts are decreasing for smoking cessation and tobacco control
- Staff time for tobacco control is decreasing
- High levels of support for tobacco control remains
- Some areas are moving towards a holistic service
- Effective cessation will be vital to help the UK become 'smoke-free'
