Skills for Health releases new Frailty Core Capabilities Framework: It aims to empower people living with frailty, and the people who support and care for them, make the most of the support available and plan for their needs, both now and in the future. As well as being a standalone resource, it complements similar frameworks for dementia, end of life care, and person-centred approaches to provide an approach to training and education which is holistic and person-centred.



The 14 capabilities are grouped into 4 domains:

Domain A. Understanding, identifying and assessing frailty

Domain B. Person-centred collaborative working

Domain C. Managing frailty

Domain D. Underpinning principles

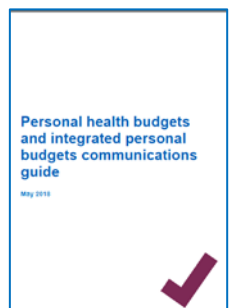
